- 3. Limestone Veterinary Hospital reserves the right to not accept a dog into daycare or boarding for any reason. All rules of boarding and/or daycare are subject to change at the sole discretion of Limestone Veterinary Hospital.
- 4. Limestone Veterinary Hospital and their staff will not be liable for any health or behavioral problems that develop in my dog(s), and I hereby release them of any liability of any kind whatsoever arising from my dog(s) attendance and participation at Doggy Daycare.
- 5. I am solely responsible for any harm, including to any other dog(s), to the employees or invitees of Limestone Veterinary Hospital's Doggy Daycare, or to the equipment, physical plant, or other property of Limestone Veterinary Hospital, caused by my dog(s) while my dog(s) is/are attending Doggy Daycare.
- 6. I certify that my dog(s) is/are free of any infectious disease and is vaccinated for DHPP (Distemper, Hepatitis, Parainfluenza, Parvo), Bordetella, and Rabies. I also certify that my pet(s) is/are free of contagious parasitic problems, whether internal or external (including fleas and ticks), and is free of any contagious skin disorder.
- 7. The arbitrator shall, as part of the award, determine an award to the prevailing party of the costs of such arbitration and reasonable attorney's fees of the prevailing party.
- 11. Hours of Operation: Monday through Thursday 7:00am to 7:00pm, Friday 7:00am to 6:00pm These may be subject to change.
- 12. We impose a \$1.00/minute late fee for dogs picked up after 7:00pm Monday through Thursday, or after 6:00pm on Friday. If your dog is not picked up by 7:30 Monday through Thursday or 6:30 on Friday, we will assume that you are boarding your pet and current boarding charges will apply.
